- 1. Review Minutes from July 2022 reviewed and accepted
- 2. Treasurer's Reports: July2022 reviewed and accepted.

4. Safety / Roads: Bill could not make the meeting tonight but gave Kim an update. He said that Mike had caught up with all the washouts. Still have an issue with Herrick Construction where they installed 2 driveways and they have either blocked or crushed one of the Town's existing culverts that was working prior to the driveways being installed. Kim explained we had budgeted \$2,000.00 for the mall items like these. Alison wanted to try and get the monies before we spent anything.

8. New News: There was a discussion on the complaints that have come up with renters over taking the area. Some people actually talking of selling. Some have sold already. Seems many rental companies are purchasing homes and properties. At present Kim has been telling them to talk to their Association to review their ordinances as most of these rental properties are in Associations that already state "no small businesses". Earl did not feel at this time the Town should take that on letting Associations deal with it for now. There was discussions on the Gartley property for sale again and what restrictions might be on that as they had renters as well as Beaver Cove Camps and Beaver Cove Marina also obviously runs as a business. Will look

into Warranty deeds to see what was written. Bur LUPC before 1973 didn't exist and the the Town came to be in 1975 so they may be grandfathered in.
