Meeting opened 6:31

Alison Nominated and elected as Chairperson of the Board

1. Minutes approved for April, 2023 approved and signed
2. Treasurer's Reports for April & May 2023 reports reviewed and accepted. Joe made a statement very plain and self-explanatory. All agreed.
3. Tax Collector and IFW April & May 2023 reports reviewed and accepted. Still waiting for an Abatement for Hank McPhearson. No liens. 16 Boat registrations already.
4. Safety / Roads & Emergency Management update: Bill talked to Mike. Weather has been affecting the grading and application of Calcium on the roads. He is waiting for a break of 2-3 good days weather wise.
5. LUPC: No permits on the site are recorded. Kim will try and make contact with Ruby to confirm.
6. School Update: Sally said there will be a Greenville school meeting but it is for the school not Union 60. There are two new Board members so orientation will be happening
7. New News/Comments: Emergency Management position has been advertised for a while now. Buzzells brought up that they felt it was a lot work for little pay. Sally said a lot of work had already been done so really just knowing process and who do you call. She felt 750 was sufficient. Alison said we learned our lesson from this past December storm. This is an operating center yes but most people stay at home to be safe. Very important to check on those around you as others may not be able to. The Director would be a coordinator for the Town, Agencies and information output. 911 addressing was brought up Kim explained Maria was trained and was trying to get the addresses out to people had run into complications and had tried on 3 different computers.

8. Letter to support Greenville in the Community Resilience Program was voted on and signed. This will allow Greenville to be eligible for more grant money. Marguerite is working with Mike Roy and John Contreni, Jaime and Deb from the Country to write a letter in support of Greenville as well. Will be doing educational outreach in the congregate housing etc. 10 individuals have agreed to serve on a committee for Beaver Cove. They will help determine what is feasible for Beaver Cove specifically. In the future Alison would like to see the Emergency Management Director attend these meetings as well. Alison thanked Sally for all her work. Bill brought up the Prong Pond Boat Landing issue He will reach out to the address Jaimie left for us from the State to see what their plans are.

Alison thanked Donna for stepping up to be Chairperson for Budget Committee.
