

GREETINGS: IN the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Beaver Cove, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Town Office, in said Town, on Friday September 20, 1991 at 7:00 o'clock in the evening to act on the following articles, to wit:

Article 1: To elect a Moderator to preside over said Meeting.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a written agreement with the Town of Greenville and the Greenville Recycling Company for a term of 1 year. Cost of this agreement to be \$846.00 and funding for same to be taken from Unappropriated Surplus.

Article 3: Be it enacted that the following ordinance concerning barking or howling dogs be adopted by the voters of the Town of Beaver Cove:

It shall be unlawful for any owner of or any person harboring any dog in the Town of Beaver Cove to permit or allow such dog to engage in habitual loud howling or barking or to conduct itself in such a manner so as to disturb the peace of any person other than the owner or owners harboring such dog.

ENFORCEMENT

Any person who observes a dog acting in violation of the ordinance may file a written complaint with the Animal Control Officer specifying the objectionable conduct of the dog, the date and time thereof, a description of the dog and name and residence, if known of the owner or other person harboring said dog. Upon receipt of such complaint, the Animal Control Officer shall issue a warning to said owner or other person harboring said dog. In the event that another complaint of such nature is received by the Animal Control Officer concerning the same animal within one (1) month from the date of the initial complaint, the Animal Control Officer shall cause a complaint to be filed before any District court in the County where such owner or keeper resides. It shall be the duty of the Animal Control Officer to enforce the provisions of the Ordinance.

PENALTY

Upon complaint before any District Court in the County where such owner or keeper resides, any person found violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a civil violation and punishable by a fine of \$25.00 for each first offense, \$50.00 for a second offense and \$100.00 for each third and subsequent offense. All fines so assessed shall be recovered for the use of the Town of Beaver Cove through the District Court.
